Dear Essential Workers,

It is not only our duty but privilege to provide childcare services for the Emergency Workers of Annandale Public Schools. Please rest assured that we are committed to providing a healthy, safe, and fun environment for your child to learn and grow.

As required by Governor Walz free childcare services will be provided Monday-Friday from 8:00 AM until 3:00 PM starting Tuesday, March 31 for those families in the Tier 1 and Tier 2 Essential Emergency Workers category. Students enrolled in Annandale Public School, or the Annandale Preschool Program, ages 4 years thru 12 years old, may attend free of charge during these hours(8:00 am -3:00 pm). If your child needs transportation to emergency care this would be provided to them during the school hours of 8:00 am and 3:00 pm. Please note they must be 4 years of age and enrolled in the Annandale Preschool Program to ride the bus.

Additionally extended day childcare services will be offered at a cost of \$3.50 per hour for services provided from 6-8 AM and 3-6 PM. There is a \$30 registration fee and additional forms to attend Extended day childcare. There is no transportation available for extended day services. Students will need to be dropped off and picked up at AES, Community Education, door #2.

For the safety and well being of our students and staff Annandale School District has implemented new regulations for illnesses, social distancing, and limited capacity please respectfully follow the guidelines we set forth:

Effective 3/18/2020, we are implementing these guidelines:

- 1.) We will prioritize childcare for Tier I and Tier 2 Essential Workers only.
- 2.) If you have alternative care, are able to work from home or have another parent at home, have older siblings who can care for younger children, you will not qualify for emergency care.
- 3.) Parents/Guardians may not enter the building. Families use the parent pick up and drop off line for care. Please call 320-274-0625 upon arrival.
- 4.) Illness: No child with a runny nose, cough, sore throat or fever over 100 will be allowed at care. Temperatures will be taken at drop off and lunch times.
